

GUIDELINES FOR PAPER SUBMISSION: OPEN ARCHAEOLOGY

Special Issue Published in Cooperation with Meso'2020 – 10th International Conference on the Mesolithic in Europe (<https://meso2020.sciencesconf.org>)

Submission of a manuscript does not necessarily imply approval for its publication in this Open Archaeology special issue. The manuscript will be subjected to a peer review procedure and its acceptance will depend on this assessment.

The authors are kindly invited to submit their contribution via the online submission system Editorial Manager available at <http://www.editorialmanager.com/opar/>

Please select the Category “SI published in cooperation with Meso'2020” to ensure that the manuscript is processed by the Guest Editors.

It is important that authors include a cover letter with their manuscript. The cover letter should explicitly state that the manuscript (or one with substantially the same content, by any of the authors) has not been previously published in any language anywhere and that it is not under simultaneous consideration or in press by another journal.

In order to achieve the deadlines of the editorial process, your contribution must necessarily be submitted before 28 February 2021.

General

There are no specific length restrictions for the overall manuscript or individual sections; however, we urge the authors to present and discuss their findings in a concise and accessible manner. We recommend a length of 4,000–10,000 words, excluding the bibliography and figure captions, and a maximum of 15 figures and tables.

Title page

The title page should include:

The name(s) of the author(s)

A concise and informative title

The affiliation(s) and address(es) of the author(s)

The e-mail address, telephone and fax numbers of the corresponding author

Abstract

The abstract should not exceed 250 words.

Keywords

Please provide 5 keywords which can be used for indexing purposes.

Text

Manuscript should be submitted in MS Word or PDF format.

Use a normal, plain font, preferable 12-points Times New Roman single line for the text.

Use the automatic page numbering function to number the pages.

Do not use field functions.

Use tab stops or other commands for indents, not the space bar.

Abbreviations

Abbreviations should be defined at first mention and used consistently thereafter.

List the abbreviations and acronyms in alphabetical order, along with their expanded form, at the end of the text.

Footnotes

Footnotes can be used to give additional information, which may include the citation of a reference included in the reference list.

Acknowledgments

Acknowledgments should be placed in a separate section before the reference list. The names of funding organizations should be written in full.

References

Please use APA 6th edition formatting style. The list of references should only include works that are cited in the text and that have been published or accepted for publication. Personal communications and unpublished works should only be mentioned in the text. Do not use footnotes or endnotes as a substitute for a reference list.

Tables

All tables are to be numbered using Arabic numerals.

Tables should always be cited in the text in consecutive numerical order.

For each table, please supply a table caption explaining the components of the table.

Identify any previously published material by giving the original source in the form of a reference at the end of the table caption.

Figures

All figures are to be numbered using Arabic numerals.

Figures should always be cited in the text in consecutive numerical order.

Please submit files at a size up to 10MB. JPG and TIFF files resolution should be 300–600 dpi.

Supplemental Material

Authors may submit essential supplementary files that additionally support their conclusions along with their manuscripts. Material must be restricted to large or complex data sets or results that cannot be readily displayed because of space or technical limitations. Material that has been published previously is not acceptable for posting as supplemental material.
